Please return this completed application along with a one page essay. The essay should give a brief account of your reasons for leaving Tisch School of the Arts, what you have done since you have been away, and an explanation of your readiness to return to Tisch.

If you have been away from Tisch for 3 years or more, you should contact the Director of Recruitment directly regarding your specific situation and be aware that you may have to reapply through the Office of Undergraduate Admissions (see contact information above).

The application, the essay, and the \$30.00 application fee are due:

July 1st for Fall readmission
November 1st for Spring readmission
April 1st for Summer readmission

Please note: Students are usually admitted in the fall semester. Not all departments are able to admit students for readmission. Readmit candidates will be considered for spring semester based on space availability.
